- 5th Concession – realignment to be bid out for fall construction, surveying in process.
- 2022 Mandatory Engineer Bridge Inspections – scheduled to be completed in June
- Ongoing regular road/equipment maintenance
- Roadside Grass cutting running two shifts, for 1 month
- Gravel Contract – complete
- Calcium - complete
- Grading: ongoing
- Ledcor is taking over for Ferrovial in June 2023 for the MTO Highways; discussions ongoing regarding treated sand options beyond June 2023 with Ledcor.

Other:

- Caribou: clay boils, filter cloth & gravel
- Finlayson: clay boils, filter cloth & gravel
- 5th Concession; clay boils, filter cloth & gravel
- Centre Line – dip – culverts & beaver control to be assessed; blasting of the hill to widen & fill in the lower section – place project towards a future funding model for affordability.
- Centre Line Road (Finlayson to Crystal Cove and Plummer to Lawrence) – defer pulverization/prep work to 2023, Surface treatment in 2024.
- Boundary Rd – getting OTR in 2022

Culverts to be replaced in 2022 (pending available time) & prior to projects planned in 2023:

M. Jones requests moving away from plastic culverts to install galvanized culverts going forward; noted there will be an increase in operational costs if switching.

- Plummer; 3 areas of concern
- East Line
- Copper Bay: 24" cross culvert, patching, brushing (fall), some ditching
- McPhail
- Culverts – Cloudslee & Duff – deferred to 2023
